The Automotive Technology program at Atlanta Technical College prepares students for careers in the automotive industry and the repair profession. It emphasizes a curriculum in automotive mechanic's theory and practical applications necessary for skillful employment. Program graduates will be well-rounded entry-level technicians. This program does not administer certification testing. The number of jobs in this field is expected to grow by 7.4% nationally and 10% in the State of Georgia over the next 10 years.
