Barbering Pathways

The Barbering program prepares students to sit for the State Board Examination. It emphasizes specialized training in safety, sanitation, hair treatments and manipulations, haircutting techniques, shaving, skin care, reception, sales, and management. The curriculum meets state licensing requirements of the Georgia State Board of Barbering.

The Barbering for Cosmetologists Technical Certificate allows the student who holds a current Master Cosmetology license to receive additional training that will qualify the student to take the examination for Barbering. Over the next 10 years, the number of jobs in this field is projected to grow by 13% nationally and 16% in Fulton and Clayton counties in Georgia.
