Early Childhood Care and Education Pathways

This program is designed to prepare students for a variety of careers in the field of early childhood education. The program emphasizes a combination of early childhood care and education theory and practical application as well as general core competencies necessary for successful employment. Graduates have qualifications to be employed in early care and education settings including childcare centers, Head start, Georgia Pre-K programs, and elementary school paraprofessional positions. Graduates of this program will receive one of five areas of specialization: program administration, paraprofessional, infant/toddler development, family childcare, and exceptionalities. Over the next 10 years, the number of jobs in this field is projected to grow by 13% nationally and 10% in Fulton and Clayton counties in Georgia.
