## Criminal Justice Pathways

The Criminal Justice Technology Degree program emphasizes a combination of criminal justice theory and practical application necessary for successful employment as well as continued educational advancement to a four-year institution. The courses in the Criminal Justice department are taught by active members of our local law enforcement agencies and legal community giving students expert, inside knowledge that cannot be gained from a textbook. Graduates who are current practitioners will benefit through enhancement of career potential. Entry-level persons will be prepared to pursue diverse opportunities in the corrections, security, investigative, and police administration fields. Completion of the Criminal Justice Technology Program does not ensure certification of officer status in Georgia. Students must seek such certification from the Peace Officer Standards and Training (P.O.S.T.) Council. The number of jobs in this field is expected to increase by 6% over the next 10 years.
