LPN to RN Bridge Program

Program Overview

The Atlanta Technical College LPN to RN Bridge Program (hereinafter referred to as "Associate of Science in Nursing") is an integral part of the parent institution and provides a broad frame of learning opportunities based on the sciences and humanities. The LPN to RN Bridge Program provides a course of study that prepares the graduate as a generalist practitioner in nursing. After successful completion of the program, the graduate has met the requirements to take the licensure examination to become a Registered Nurse.

Minimum Program Length after Pre-requisites: 3 Semesters

Estimated Program Cost: \$12,726

Entrance & Admission Requirements

- Candidates must be 18-years-old.
- Must hold a current, active, unencumbered and unrestricted Georgia LPN license at the time admitted into the program. Must maintain the LPN license until receive the registered nursing license.
- Admitted student to ATC, in good academic standing. Completed ASN program application.
- Cumulative GPA 2.5 or higher.
- Complete *all* required **pre-requisite** courses with a grade of (B) or higher in BIOL 2113 (Anatomy & Physiology I), BIOL 2113L (Anatomy & Physiology Lab I), BIOL 2114 (Anatomy & Physiology II), BIOL 2114L (Anatomy & Physiology Lab II), BIOL 2117 (Introductory Microbiology), BIOL 2117L (Introductory Microbiology Lab) **must be completed within the last 5 years.**
- Have a minimum grade of (B) in MATH 1111 or MATH 1101.
- Each applicant is required to take the TEAS exam. The score must be 65% or above to be considered for the program. Scores are valid for two (2) years.
