PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING:

- Full-time is a minimum of 4 classes. Students who attend part-time will take more semesters to complete the program. The A.A.S requires 69 credits (all courses are 3 credits except for the internships which are 6) AND the post-bacchaloreaute certificate requires 30 credits.
- If a course is needed to graduate, but not offered during a semester, students can use Georgia Virtual College (GVTC) as a resource to take it online at another TCSG College.
- Transfer credit of paralegal courses is contingent upon approval by the Program Coordinator and must comply with the requirements of the American Bar Association & the Technical College System of Georgia.
- Introduction to Law & Ethics (PARA 1100) must be taken along with your first legal specialty classes.
- Students enrolled in the Paralegal Studies AAS degree program or Paralegal Studies TCC program must complete at least **25 percent** of the legal specialty (Paralegal) courses at Atlanta Technical College.
- Nine hours must be completed in either a traditional classroom format or in a synchronous learning instruction.
- The ATC Paralegal Studies Program does not award any legal specialty transfer credit through examination or portfolios.

B = Blended is a combination of online and face-to-face instruction.

OA = Asynchronous online is a course that does not have a meeting time. Students access lectures, readings, homework, and other learning materials entirely online.

OS = Synchronous online is a course that has a virtual meeting time.
