

Electrical Line-worker Program Information

- This is an 8-week course, earning 12 semester hours and a Technical Certificate of Credit.
 Class meets Monday-Thursday, 8:00 am- 4:30 pm in room 2220, Hank Aaron Academic
 Complex. On Fridays from 8:00 am 2:00 pm students meet at the CDL training lot for
 instruction to prepare to take the class-A driver's test.
- Tuition and fees are approximately \$2,342. Students who are Georgia residents are encouraged to apply for the Georgia HOPE Grant which will pay a portion of tuition for eligible students (this amount may vary by number of credits).
- All students are required to obtain a Class A CDL instructional permit to become
 eligible for admission to the program. Students should prepare for the knowledge tests by
 picking up a manual at their local DDS office or by viewing it online at www.dds.ga.gov. Tests
 required include General Knowledge, Combination, and Air Brakes.
- Students must pass a drug screen to continue in the program. (This is a requirement to operate a class-A vehicle). The physical exam and drug screen costs are the student's responsibility. Financial aid does not cover these costs.
- Mornings are usually spent in the classroom and afternoons are spent training on our Skills Field. Training on the Skills Field will be conducted in all types of weather; plan accordingly (rain gear, heavy coat, sunscreen, insect repellent).
- Steel shank boots must be worn by students. Blue jeans and t-shirts (tucked in) are the acceptable dress code. Jewelry is not allowed. Hard hats and safety glasses will be provided. Students need to bring leather work gloves to class.
- Students should schedule their class-A license road test during the first or second week of the class to enhance chances of getting a test date before the class ends. Testing arrangements and fees are the student's responsibility.

- Here are the items students will need to purchase (financial aid will cover these items) <u>ONLY</u>
 if purchased at ATC's bookstore:
 - o 12" adjustable wrench
 - o 9" lineman's pliers
 - o 6' folding rule (non-conductive)
 - Large flat head screwdriver (minimum 6")
 - Skinning knife
 - o 32-oz ball peen hammer
 - Channel locks
