## Accounting Pathways

Accounting programs prepare individuals to practice the profession of accounting and to perform related business functions. The curriculum includes instruction in accounting principles and theory, financial accounting, managerial accounting, cost accounting, budget control, tax accounting, legal aspects of accounting, auditing, reporting procedures, statement analysis, planning and consulting, business information systems, accounting research methods, professional standards and ethics, and applications to specific for-profit, public, and non-profit organizations. Over the next 10 years, the number of jobs in this field is projected to grow by 4.1% nationally and 7.3% in Fulton and Clayton counties in Georgia.
