The Air Conditioning Technology program prepares students for careers in the heating and air conditioning industry. The program is designed to provide students with the basic knowledge, skills, work habits, and practical applications of air conditioning systems required for entry-level employment in today's air conditioning industry. Graduates will be able to efficiently perform in the installation, maintenance, and service of air conditioning systems. The number of jobs in this field are expected to increase by 20.2% nationally and 3.6% in the State of Georgia over the next 10 years.
