The Avionics Bench Technician certificate program prepares students for employment in the field of avionics maintenance technology-aircraft electronics. Graduates of this program are qualified to work on aircraft electronics in avionics repair stations and should be prepared to sit for the General Radio Operating License (GROL) exam. The number of jobs in this field is projected to grow 7.3% nationally.
