Carpentry Pathways

The Carpentry program prepares students for careers in carpentry and construction. It emphasizes a combination of carpentry theory and practical applications necessary for successful employment. Program graduates will have the qualifications for an entry-level residential carpenter or entry-level commercial carpenter. The number of jobs in this field is expected to increase by 11% nationally and 14% in the State of Georgia over the next 10 years.
