As one of the oldest professions in healthcare, nursing is a critical component of patient care. In the ever-changing field of healthcare, the role of nurses has never been more crucial, challenging and rewarding. The Atlanta Technical College Associate of Science in Nursing Degree Program is an integral part of the parent institution and provides a broad frame of learning opportunities based on the sciences and humanities. The ASN Program provides a course of study that prepares the graduate as a generalist practitioner in nursing. The program prepares the student to practice with a diverse population across the life span. The curriculum design moves from simple to complex and education is guided by the use of the nursing process as well as critical thinking. Throughout this program, experiences both didactic and clinical develops the individual's ability to provide quality nursing care. After successful completion of the program, the graduate has met the requirements to take the licensure examination to become a Registered Nurse. The number of jobs in this field is expected to increase by 19.3% nationally and 23.2% in the State of Georgia over the next 10 years.
