Pharmacy Technology Pathways

The Pharmacy Technology program prepares students for employment in pharmacy departments in hospitals, clinics, long-term care facilities, commercial businesses, and other related facilities. Program graduates are eligible to sit for a national certification exam for pharmacy technologists. The number of jobs in this field are projected to grow by 13% both nationally and in the State of Georgia over the next 10 years.

The Pharmacy Technology program at Atlanta Technical College is accredited by the American Society of Health-Systems Pharmacists.
