Procurement & Supply Chain Management Pathways

These programs prepare students for real-world foundational understanding of the supply chain infrastructure. Students will understand the complex knowledge and skills necessary to manage various supply chain logistics entry-level functions. Areas covered include fundamentals of supply chain management including procurement, issues in executing global supply chains, introduction to global sourcing, basics of supplier negotiation, logistics and transportation. It also includes business management, accounting principles, business communications, economics of supply and demand, computer fundamentals, and database management skills. The Associate Degree programs are designed to maximize options for students who wish to continue to bachelor's degree programs at four-year institutions. Of the three available options, the Supply Chain Associate of Science would provide the most transferability to four-year institutions as it comprises the greatest amount of fully transferable general education courses. Students may earn starting salaries of up to \$70,000/year with a Bachelor's degree in this field. Atlanta Technical College can be an affordable entry point to this lucrative and in-demand field. The number of jobs in this field are expected to increase by 2% nationally and 6% in the State of Georgia over the next 10 years.
