This program focuses on Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) systems in the Supply Chain Management industry. Graduates of the Technical Certificate of Credit in Transportation Management Systems become specialist in planning, execution, and monitoring processes in the transportation industry. The Transportation Management Systems TCC enables graduates to identify the transportation network structures and explain their logistics benefits and costs, service quality, and management concerns. The hands-on exercises have been designed to enable graduates to configure a series of scenarios in respect to transportation planning and optimization, freight tendering, order management, transportation planning, selection of carriers, charge management, regulation and compliance adherence, reviewing international operations, packaging, documenting, and familiarizing with economic issues in international operations. The number of jobs in this field are expected to increase by 14% nationally and 10% in the State of Georgia over the next 10 years.
